How does it go: "treat them mean, keep them keen"? Basically Moscow has had enough of the Minsk process, and talking with the Europeans; its ideal scenario all along has been a Great Power get together, with the Americans to sort all the world's problems out, and to deal. The Volker-Surkov process is all part of this, albeit I doubt Volker has been given the same remit.
