The arrest has been imposed on all the movable and immovable property of the suspect, [as well as] money located in banking institutions on the territory of Ukraine, the television station quotes the National Police as saying. It was noted that the relevant decision was taken as part of the General Prosecutor's Office of Ukraine investigation of criminal proceedings on suspicion of Zakharchenko's involvement in a number of crimes during the Ukrainian Revolution of Dignity. Zakharchenko also followed the familiar pattern of seeking Russian government protection and high level employment with companies close to President Vladimir Putin.
