This psychological drama is about a father at odds with his own son who sides with the Bolshevik revolution while his father remains faithful to the old order. The political awakening that the father undergoes under the influence of the stormy events of the Russian Soviet re-conquest of Ukraine in 1918-1920 will move even the most indifferent of hearts.
