In a country where there are more guns than people, a new record was set today.

The suspect, 64-year-old Stephen Paddock, killed himself before police breached his hotel room. What we know so far: • A gunman opened fire from his hotel room overlooking a country music festival in Las Vegas on Sunday night. • At least 58 people were killed and more than 500 others injured, making it the deadliest mass shooting in modern U.S. history. • Among the dead is an off-duty Las Vegas police officer.
