Russia&rsquo;s "Decade of Sport" might have worked out okay for the man who delivered that speech in heavily-accented English in the Central American backwater: President Vladimir Putin, progenitor of New Russia, looks as securely ensconced in the Kremlin as ever, more than 18 years after he first moved in. But for the world of sport, first and foremost the International Olympic Committee (IOC), it has been little short of a disaster, a cautionary tale illustrating the wisdom of that homely but time-honoured dictum about not putting all your eggs in one basket.
